This course will provide the LEO with the necessary life-saving skills needed until EMS can arrive, or the LEO can reach a trauma center. During the class, we will cover such things as; application of tourniquets, treating a sucking chest wound, airway emergencies, prevention of shock and movement of casualties.

This class will be a combination of lecture and skills applications. The entire class will revolve around the principles of Tactical Emergency Casualty Care (TECC) and not particular products used. In doing this, the LEO will be able to improvise trauma care if need be.
